SCSC ORGANIZED FIRE PREVENTION, FIREFIGHTING AND RESCUE DRILL

On December 16th, 2025, at SCSC Office Building, SCSC coordinated with Fire Prevention, Fire-fighting and Rescue Police Team – Area 14 (PC07 Department) to organize a fire prevention, firefighting and search and rescue drill, aiming to enhance safety awareness and emergency response capabilities.
